

UC 937 Barley



UC 937 is a 6 row awned spring barley released for commercial production in the mid 1990's. Fast germination makes UC 937 a perfect choice for cover crop and weed suppression, early-crop silage or grain, and with ample early vigor, it makes it an ideal choice for fodder.

UC 937 is mid-to-late season maturing, short statured, six-rowed with semi-smooth awns. It is slightly later, 3-4 days to flower versus Ishi, but similar to Ishi maturity at harvest.

In tests where stripe rust was at epidemic levels, UC 937 yielded 8,000 lbs/acre.

UC 937 can be planted singly or as part of a cover crop mix for improving soil tilth and nutrient cycling in perennial cropping systems.

Plant at 80-120 Lbs/ac. Use a lower rate early (Oct-Nov10), higher rates after Nov 10.
